Upon which a discussion arose, in which Messrs. Jewett, Cooke, Burgess, Whittlesev, J. Reed, Taylor, Hoffman, Doddridge, Polk, Mc-Duffie, Arnold, Stanberry, and Blair, of South Carolina, took part, when the question was taken and the resolution rejected, ayes 85, noes 87. Mr. Adams presented a report upon the bank investigation, of which, with other reports and documents, ten thousand copies were ordered to be printed. Mr. Polk moved to postpone all the orders of the day, for the purpose of taking up the apportionment bill, which was agreed to. Mr. E. Everett proposed an amendment to the resolution reported by the Select Committee, which he proposed to support by a few remarks, which, after sitting five hours, he was unwilling to go on with, and moved an adjourement, with was carried.
