

In the House of Representatives, Mr. Wardwell presented resolutions adopted by the Legislature of the State New York, in opposition to the re-charter of the Bank of the United States. Mr. Wickliffe, from the Committee on the Public Lands, reported a bill for the final adjustment of private land claims in the State of Missouri. The resolution for the appointment of a Select Committee to examine the affairs of the Bank of the United States, was again taken up.
